Corrective Surgery Quite a few of our clients have come to us in need of corrective surgery after a cosmetic procedure has gone wrong at another clinic. Unfortunately, as saddened as we are to see patients who have been injured in this manner, we are unable to perform these corrective surgeries free of charge. However, you will still need some additional care afterward. Because, as mentioned previously, elective surgeries are not covered by health insurance or provincial health care, be aware that an overnight stay (private vs. semi-private room, for example) can also add to this cost. While some clinics also offer the option of an overnight stay, this can sometimes be even more expensive than a hospital stay. This is because the clinic will have to ensure staff on duty 24 hours a day, this is not the case for most clinics. Scar Treatment After any surgical procedure, it's normal for at least some scarring to appear. It's unavoidable. How visible the scars are can depend on several factors, including where the incisions are made, and even the patients themselves. Everyone's body is differently. Scars do fade over time, but can still be noticeable for many years. If you're concerned about this, you can opt for scar removal, which can help to fade scars more quickly than they would on their own.
